DISCUSSION ITEMS	
2024 Budget – Property Tax Landscape and Library Budget	Pasicznyuk stated that the landscape has quieted a bit legislatively. We are not expecting legislation to limit property tax growth to 3% this year, although it is likely to come back next year.
	It is still possible that HH (the Governor's bill) is going to go to the voters.
	The budget presented shows a 18% increase with remaining money going back to voters. The budget as an average would be 7% over the next two years (aside from any unknown legislative changes), and in line with historical averages of 6% while allowing for recovery from last year's reduced revenue.
	Cook reviewed the proposed 2024 budget.



	Corrente reviewed the Salaries & Wages portion of the proposed budget and the work with Brown & Brown Consultants.
Board Terms and Term Limits discussion post Board of County Commissioner interaction on this topic.	The board consensus is to keep terms and term limits as approved in the bylaws.
